Terms and Conditions

1. Entry into the HAWAIIAN 2020 WOMENS WALK FOR CANCER Dollar Match Day Promotion ("Promotion") is deemed to be an acceptance of these Conditions of Entry. Information on how to enter the Promotion and prizes associated with the Promotion form part of these Conditions of Entry.
2. The Promoter in all States and Territories are Harry Perkins Institute of Medical Research 6 Verdun Street, Nedlands WA 6009 (ABN 16 823 190 402) (the Promoter).
3. Entries for the Promotion commence on 08:00 Thursday, 12 March 2020 and close at 11:59hrs Thursday, 12 March 2020 ("Promotion Period") unless the overall value \$50,000.00 is reached prior.
4. Entry is open to registered HAWAIIAN 2020 WOMENS WALK FOR CANCER participants ("Entrants").

6. The Total Promotion Pool is valued at \$50,000.00 (Total Promotion Pool).
7. The Entrant's donations received during the Promotion Period will receive a dollar match from WOMENS WALK FOR CANCER, up to the value of each donation to a maximum of \$500 towards their fundraising goal (Prize), provided that the Total Promotion Pool is not exceeded.
8. Calculations will be conducted at time of donation and then verified on 20 March 2020 at the Harry Perkins Institute of Medical Research, 6 Verdun Street, Nedlands WA 6009
