1 REQUEST AN ATF & INSURANCE

Contact walk@perkins.org.au for an Authority to Fundraise and Insurance Certificate. You will need to complete the required insurance request form which will detail all nominated volunteers.

2 CONTACT YOUR LOCAL BUNNINGS STORE

Call the Activities Organiser at your local Bunnings Store in your catchment area (e.g. if you reside in Greenwood then Balcatta will be your closest store). You can use Google Maps to locate the Bunnings Stores in your area or click [here](#).

3 ASK FOR AVAILABLE DATES

Keep in mind that Harry Perkins Institute of Medical Research is a third party fundraiser and smaller community groups are given priority. Bunnings will try to accommodate your request but please understand that approval will depend on availability. Speak to the Activities Organiser (AO) to find out what dates are available and inform them that you have the relevant documentation. Ask if you can book more than one sizzle, and if you can, do it!

4 VOLUNTEERS

The number of volunteers required for your Sausage Sizzle would depend on the size of the event and the expected number of attendees, but typically, it is recommended to have at least 4-6 volunteers.

Ask your AO for advice and think about breaking your list of volunteers into shifts over the day, and appointing one delegate to manage the whole day. The day typically runs from 7am to 4.30pm (including setup time), but this can vary between the stores.



5 WHAT TO BRING

Your local Bunnings will provide you with a list of recommended quantities of items to bring, based on the day and expected volume of trade. The list of items can include:

Sausages	Oil
Bread rolls	Cleaning cloths
Onions	BBQ scraper
Sauces	Aprons
Soft Drinks	Disposable gloves
Serviettes	Ice
Tongs	Aluminium trays/foil
Knives	Cash Float
Eskies	Hand sanitiser
Butter	

6 WHERE TO GET YOUR ITEMS

Leverage your networks to source cheap or free food, drinks and items. Ask all your local shops to donate produce or gift cards. The worst thing they can say is no!

Hot tip: buy pre-sliced onions!

7 HOW MUCH CAN YOU EXPECT TO RAISE?

The amount raised can vary depending on the day and how busy the store is, but most sizzle sales can generate upwards of \$500.

8 DONATION CHANGE

Put a donation box on the table, and prompt people to donate their change!

9 SIGNAGE

Table signage can be placed on the condiments table for promotional purposes. Please note that large pull-up banners are not permitted.
